### Goal Setting Day – Tuesday, September 3

The first day of the 2019 – 2020 school year is Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The School District of Bloomer will kick off the year by again leading welcome back / goal setting conferences for all students.

Each parent / guardian and high school student will be scheduled to participate in a 20 – minute conference with the student's advisor and **attendance at a conference is mandatory for each student.** The focus of these conferences will be to set age – appropriate goals in three areas: academics, personal and career. Prior to your conference, please spend time with your child considering strengths and areas for growth in these three areas, along with how we can assist in ensuring your child has a successful school year.

### Fee Schedule

Fees for the 2019 – 2020 school year are as follows:

Athletic	\$50.00 / season
Class Dues	\$ 5.00 (none for seniors)
Materials Fee	\$20.00 / year
Chromebook Fee	\$20.00 / year
Parking Tag	\$32.00 / year

The fees for parking tags are prorated according to the trimester in which they are purchased. **Only juniors and seniors will be allowed to purchase parking tags through Friday, September 13<sup>th</sup>.** Beginning on Monday, September 16<sup>th</sup>, any remaining tags will be sold on a first – come, first – served basis to any student presenting a valid driver's license.
